

## Engineering:

- **Info4Education**

Contains full-text of Standards, monographs and periodicals pertaining to the regulatory aspect of the Irish and UK Construction Industry and Occupational Health and Safety. This service also includes access to catalogues covering construction engineering, process & electronic industries.

- **British Standards Online**

British Standards Online is the definitive site for all publications from British Standards Institution. The site contains bibliographic information on more than 47,000 documents covering: Current, historic, and draft British Standards, more than 27,000 BSI adopted European and international standards, technical handbooks, codes of practice, guidelines specifications for products, dimensions, and performance and glossaries

## Science:

- **ISI Web of Science**

Provides seamless access to Science Citation Expanded, Social Sciences Citation Index, Arts & Humanities Citation Index & Chemicus and Current Chemical Reactions. Enables users to search current and retrospective multidisciplinary information from approximately 8,700 of the most prestigious, high impact research journals in the world. Web of Science also provides a unique search method, cited reference searching.

- **Wiley InterScience**

Wiley InterScience is an international leader in the provision of quality content across a broad range of disciplines, including science, technology and medicine. It provides access to full-text journals, reference works, books and databases from around the world. All users can browse and search the table of contents and abstracts of 1400 journals, and full-text is available on subscribed titles.



- **Science Direct**

Users of this online service can access a critical mass of the World's Science, Technology and Medicine (STM) journal titles and full text articles. This includes over 2500 online journal titles, over 9m online articles plus an extra 59m article summaries as well as over 6.8m links from citations and 50m linked web pages. Users can register to set up their own profiles, save searches, get email alerts etc.

## Nursing and Health:

- **EBSCO Health Source Nursing & CINAHL**



Provides more than 550 scholarly full-text journals, focusing on many medical disciplines. This database also provides access to up-to-date, concise & clinically relevant drug books for all U.S. prescription drugs, hard-to-find herbal and nutritional supplements, over-the-counter products and new drugs.

## Multi-Disciplinary:

### • *Academic Search Premier*

Scholarly, multi-disciplinary full text database containing full text for over 4,650 scholarly publications, including more than 3,900 peer-reviewed publications. This database covers social sciences, humanities, education, computer sciences, engineering, physics, chemistry, linguistics, arts & literature, medical sciences, ethnic studies, and more.

### • *General OneFile*

A one-stop source for news and periodical articles on a wide range of topics including, business, computers, current events, economics, education, environmental issues, healthcare, humanities, law, literature & art, politics and science. It contains over 85 million articles and is updated on a daily basis.

### • *Academic OneFile*

Premier source for peer-reviewed, full-text articles from the world's leading journals and reference sources. It has extensive coverage of the physical sciences, technology, medicine, social sciences, the arts, theology, literature and other subjects.



## Art & Design:

### • *Art Abstracts:*

Art Abstracts contains the bibliographic contents of over 370 leading art journals, museum bulletins and yearbooks.

## Business Studies:

### • *Factfinder*

Allows searching of business stories in Irish national newspapers back to 1992, articles from 130 Irish business magazines back to 1991, daily Business and Finance newswire stories from 1996 onwards and international newswire stories since November 2000.

### • *Business Source Premier*



Database of over 2,300 full-text journals and magazines. It also includes full-text market research reports, industry reports, country reports, company profiles, and SWOT (strengths, weaknesses, opportunities & threats) analyses.



## Humanities:

### • *Emerald*

The Emerald Library provides abstract and full text access to an electronic journal collection of management, engineering and library services journals from MCB University Press. This is a growing resource for management titles in both academic and corporate institutions throughout the World.

### • *Wilson OmniFile*

Gives electronic access to full text articles, page images, article abstracts, and citations from over 4,000 journals. Coverage back as early as 1982. Users have access to information on virtually any subject including Education, General Science, Humanities, Social Sciences and Business Full Text.



### • *JSTOR: The Ireland Collection*

Complementing JSTOR's existing collections, the Ireland Collection adds titles and resources across the arts, humanities, and sciences in disciplines such as music, art, history, literature, archaeology, mathematics, and biology. Materials span from the 1780s to the present. The content is international in scope, while also providing a rich focus on Ireland.
