# You Said: Problem connecting to Wi-Fi

#### We Said:

We are aware that there is an issue with Wi-Fi in the library - we've reported the issues to the IT Department. Unfortunately, unless there are resources to provide additional access points, the strength of the signal in the library cannot be increased.

We understand that some users are frustrated with only being allowed to book one hour, but these rooms are for group study so there must be at least two people in the room to book/use them - that's a two hour booking at a time per group. This is to ensure fair usage for all student groups.
