The study hubs in CCAM library are so unpractical. My back is sore from trying to study and work at the desks for longer than 30 minutes. Can we please replace the majority wooden 90 degree angle church chairs with more suitable chairs. At CCAM the height of the chairs and desk are not ergonomic. Desks too low for the chairs, have to stoop to work on desktop. Study tables are not comfortable. They are too short and may affect the spine. Large table removed and 4 smaller tables installed.
More production design books	The Library purchased a significant number of design books listed in Module Manager. The library also informed the Head of School and Head of Department of available book funding should they wish to order more material.

What we couldn't do
No funding available as yet but there is survey
being conducted by Buildings & Estates to make
the main entrance more accessible.

Make the stairs safer with highlighted step edges and make access through the ground floor simpler.	Library sourced a quote for carpet for the stairs with safety curves for the edges but no funding was available to proceed with the purchase. However, the library will continue to lobby for funding for this purpose.
Longer opening hours	Library staffing levels have been reduced and staff have not been replaced in CCAM. Dublin rd campus has to cover two campuses and this is proving challenging and impacting on opening hours. The library continues to lobby for the appointment of a full time GIII for CCAM.
