

## Databases

The library databases are online collections of journal articles and other documents on various subjects.

### Where can I find them?

Go to **library.gmit.ie** to search databases.

- Most of the library databases are searchable using the **Search + Find** box on the library website. That's the first search box you see. When you find the article or document you want, click on its title. This will bring you into the database where you can view or print the article.
- You can also use the **databases** search button on the library website to go directly to a specific database.

### Which databases should I search?

These are some of our most popular film and documentary databases. The ones marked with this symbol 🔍 are searchable using the Search + Find box on the library website.

This means that you can search more than one database at a time.

#### **Academic Search Complete** 🔍

Scholarly full-text articles on a wide range of topics

#### **Omnifile Fulltext Mega** 🔍

Coverage includes the arts, photography, film and tv

#### **JSTOR** 🔍

Coverage includes the arts, photography, film and tv

#### **Arts and Humanities Citation Index** 🔍

Index of articles on art, film and tv.

#### **Irish Newspaper Archive**

Archive of local and national Irish newspapers

#### **Irish Times Online**

Access to *Irish Times* online archive dating back to 1859

## How do I find film and documentary information in the library?

- Use the **library website** to search for books, ebooks, journal articles, dvds, theses, exam papers and more. **library.gmit.ie**
- When you find the book you want on the website you'll see its shelf number, this will help you find it in the library.
- For online items, like ebooks, simply click on the link to read it online or download.
- You may be asked to login to view online items. Use your GMIT email and password.

## Ebooks

- An ebook is a book that is available to read or download online.

## DVDs

The DVD collection includes art history, films, documentaries and television series. DVDs are shelved beside the information desk on the Ground Floor.

## Journals

Journals, like magazines, are published on a regular basis. They contain articles written by experts in a particular field of study and are an excellent source of up-to-date information.

## Find journals on the shelves...

There is a wide variety of film journals in our collection on the Ground Floor. They are arranged in alphabetical order. Older issues of journals are held in the journal archive on the fourth floor.

## Find journals online...

The quickest way to find journal articles is online.

- Go to **library.gmit.ie** to search for journal articles.
- Use the **E-journals** search button to find specific journals.

## Theses

A thesis is a long essay on a particular subject. Diploma and Degree in Art theses, written by GMIT students up to 2016, are on the Ground Floor.
