## Self-archive in an OA Repository

Deposit your research to an OA repository, e.g. [Research@THEA](#), uploading your research into a shared institutional repository complements, not replaces, existing publishing processes.

## OA Journals with no Publishing Charges

The Directory of Open Access Journals [\(DOAJ\)](#) lists over 10,000 trustworthy OA journals, which do not charge authors OA publishing costs. Furthermore, a number of research funding organisations have publishing platforms that permit eligible grantees to publish OA at no cost to authors i.e. [HRB Open Research](#), [Open Research Europe](#) and [Wellcome Open Research](#).

## Publishing Agreement with Elsevier
