

Databases

The library databases are online collections of journal articles and other documents on various subjects.

Where can I find them?

Go to **atu.ie/library** to search databases.

Most of the library databases are searchable using the **Search + Find** box on the library website.

When you find the article or document you want, click on its title. This will bring you into the database where you can view or print the article.

You can also use the **databases** search button on the library website to go directly to a specific database.

Which databases should I search?

These are some of our most popular business databases. The ones marked with this symbol are searchable using the **Search + Find** box on the library website. This means that you can search more than one database at a time.

Journal articles on a wide range of business and management topics.

Academic Search Ultimate

Journal articles on business and management.

Omnifile Fulltext Mega

Journal articles on business and management topics.

Science Direct

Journal articles on business, management, economics, finance and accountancy.

Irish Times Online

Access to *Irish Times* online archive dating back to 1859.

Irish Newspaper Archive

Access to an archive of national and local Irish newspapers.

Taxfind

Tax information from the Institute of Taxation in Ireland. *Password available in Library.*
