Databases

The library databases are large online collections of journal articles and other documents on various subjects, which make it easy for you to find information.

Where can I find them?

Go to atu.ie/library to search databases.

- Most of the library databases are searchable using the **Search + Find** box on the library website.
- When you find the article or document you want, click on its title. This will bring you into the database where you can view or print the article.
- You can also use the **databases** search button on the library website to go directly to a specific database.

Which databases should I search?

These are some of our most popular engineering databases. The ones marked with this symbol are searchable using the **Search + Find** box on the library website. This means that you can search more than one database at a time.


